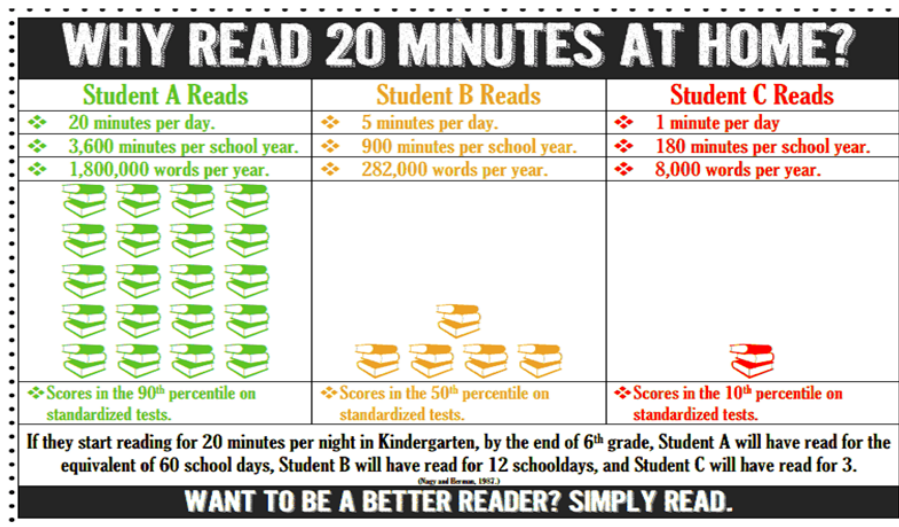
### SCHOOL NEWS:
