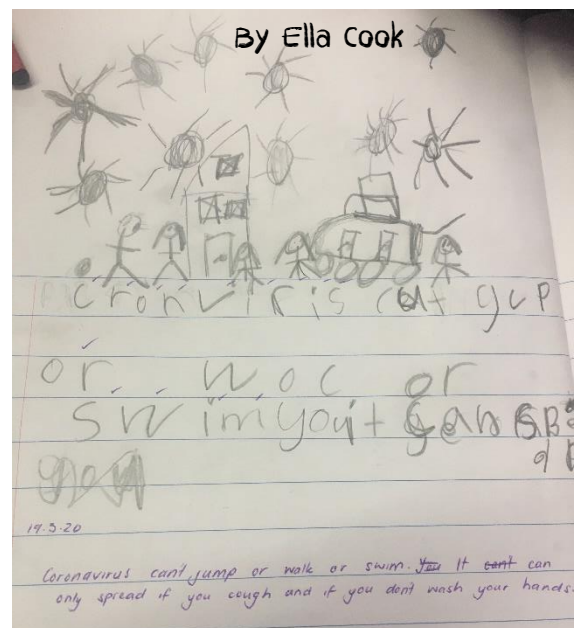

#### **SCHOOL NEWS:**


We will be sending student attendance data to the Ministry weekly, from 29 May. The purpose is to:
