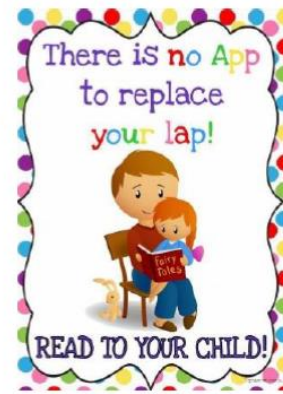

THREE WAY CONFERENCES

Three way conferences are designed to achieve the following goals:

- 🌀 to help ākongā demonstrate evidence of learning
- 🌀 to teach ākongā the process of reflection and self-evaluation
- 🌀 to encourage ākongā and parents to engage in open and honest dialogue about the learning
- 🌀 one on one value time with the child, whereby the child takes ownership of telling their parent about their learning
- 🌀 to encourage ākongā to accept personal responsibility for their learning

During the conference the children will provide evidence of progress and achievement.

They will discuss work samples and parents/caregivers will be able to ask questions.


It is important that you discuss and then agree on the learning goals/ next steps in learning for your child based on the evidence.

The interview is 15minutes. During this time the children may also discuss with you things within the room that they are proud of.
