## Overview of the Key Changes to our Covid Response:

You will no doubt have heard about the recent announcement whereby a range of Covid restrictions are being relaxed. At our school I have bullet pointed the key points:

The removal of vaccination mandates for education workers will take effect from 11.59pm Monday 4 April.

You will not need to scan in using our QR code posters at the gate. You will still need to sign in the office.

Medical-grade masks **remain a requirement** for staff working indoors with children and young people in Years 4-8.

Capacity limits will be removed for outdoor events and activities.

Indoor capacity limits for extra-curricular activities increase to 200 people (one metre rule still applies)

No Vaccine passes are required onsite.
